

## DEGREE REQUIREMENTS CHECKLIST

### M.S. Business Administration: Option 4 – General Business

**A minimum of 33 credits are required for the degree; Effective Fall 2014**

**Core (5 courses; 15 credits):** Take ALL of the following courses:

**Option 4 students with permission of the graduate deputy may substitute any or all courses from the above graduate core with any business course, but this is rare.**

**Option 4. General Business** A total of 33 credits with a minimum of 18 credits (6 courses) from any Business graduate course. As noted above, the 5 graduate program core classes may be substituted by additional Business courses with permission of the graduate deputy.

**Courses in Other Departments and at Other Institutions:** With permission of the graduate deputy chairperson, up to 12 graduate credits may be accepted for **graduate** courses completed for work done at other institutions.

**Prerequisites:** All applicants must have undergraduate courses in macroeconomics, microeconomics, statistics, and calculus. These undergraduate courses can't be transferred to the graduate program and do not exempt you from taking graduate courses with similar course names. Undergraduate courses are **not** equivalent to graduate courses.
